

How and where do you get the information on the VIP web site?

Voter Information Project (VIP) volunteers gather most of the information to contact the candidates from the individual county web sites, and through Election Commissioner's offices. Candidates are then called by a volunteer (usually by someone within that candidate's district), and are given the opportunity to respond to VIP's questions online. Occasionally a candidate's phone number is not available. Those candidates, in some cases, are mailed a VIP questionnaire. Candidates also can provide their answers by email, fax, Postal Service, and on rare occasions, over the phone.
